**Easy-to-Make Jello Aquarium**

Use some jello and candy to make this fishy aquarium. Shine a light through it to see it at its best. Then you can eat it!

**You Will Need:**

- Large glass bowl or clear plastic container
- 3 or 6 (3 oz) packets of blue jello powder
- 1 cup (250 ml) hot water
- 1/2 cup (125 ml) cold water
- Jolly beans or round gummies
- Fish-shaped gummy candy
- Green licorice or twisted candy

**Fun Facts**

- The smallest fish is a carp that comes from Sumatra, in Indonesia. It is only about 0.2 inches (7 mm) long—about the size of your pinky fingertip!
- Scientists have found that guppies can be trained to link certain sounds with feeding time. They can even remember these sounds up to five months later.
- Fish breathe by taking oxygen from the water. They have lungs into their mouths, where it moves over special organs called gills. The gills absorb oxygen from the water, which then passes into the fish's bloodstream.
- Scientists who study fish are called ichthyologists (ICK-thee-oh-yehs).
- Fish have been swimming in the oceans for about 450 million years!
- The largest fish in the world is the whale shark. It can grow up to 40 feet (12 m) long. That's about the length of a school bus!
- Female seahorses lay their eggs in a pouch on the male's body. The eggs stay in the pouch for about 43 days, until they are ready to hatch.

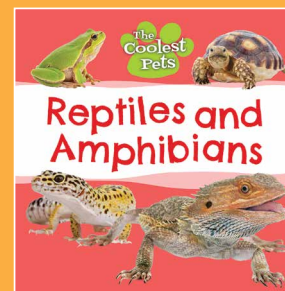
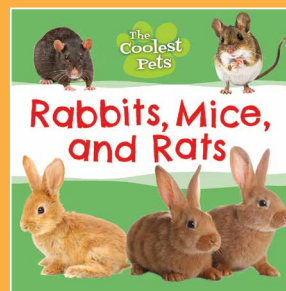
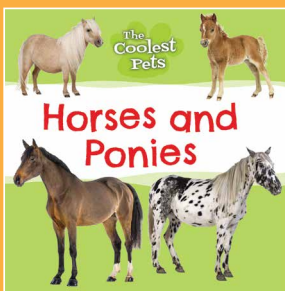
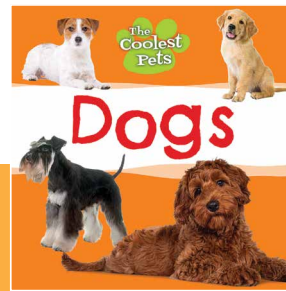
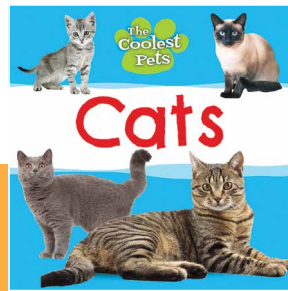
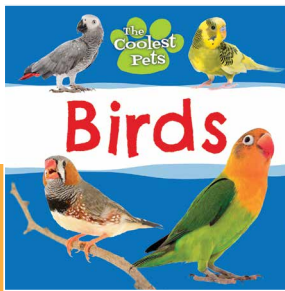
Help your cat keep its coat clean with regular grooming sessions. Most cats clean their coats every day unless they are in pain or they are ill. Grooming keeps the coat clean. It also removes loose hair.

**Open Wide**  
 Can't clean, healthy teeth, just as people do. Start cleaning your cat's teeth when it is a kitten so that it gets used to it. Ask an adult to help you. Use the soft toothbrush. Cat toothpaste from a pet store. You can use an animal toothbrush, a finger brush, or a piece of cloth. If your cat is not used to having its teeth cleaned, ask the vet to do it.

**Combing and Brushing**  
 Short-haired cats normally need grooming about once a week. Comb your cat from head to tail, and then use a bristle brush on its coat. Many long-haired cats need grooming every day or their fur can become matted. Use a wide-tooth comb or slicker brush to gently loose cat mats. Use a comb to pull out hair and hurt your cat. Use a bristle brush for the cat. Spray-on conditioner can help smooth out any tangles.

**Hairballs**  
 Fur from a cat's coat can build up in the stomach. This causes hairballs. Your cat coughs them up, but you can help prevent them with regular grooming.

**Look Out for Fleas**  
 Look out for flea dirt—small, dark specks on the skin. If your cat has fleas, ask an adult to give it some anti-flea treatment. Ask an adult to help check for and remove any ticks.

Often, governments talk to public health experts to help them make laws that keep everyone safe and healthy. For example, in the United States, children have to be vaccinated against diseases such as mumps and polio before they can go to school or daycare.

Not everyone likes that there are laws about health. Some people think they should be allowed to do whatever they want. However, the laws don't say people have to make certain choices. They only say that people who decide not to make certain choices can't be around other people. This is a consequence of their choices.

The word "quarantine" comes from the Latin word for 40. Between 1377 and 1403, many European cities passed a law saying ships had to wait at port for 40 days to make sure all diseases onboard had passed.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, cities and states made laws that said everyone needed to wear a mask in public places such as schools and doctors' offices. This helped stop the spread of the disease. The laws were changed after a COVID-19 vaccine was made.

## When Prices Go Up

The value of money doesn't always stay the same. Inflation is when the prices for goods and services in an economy go up. This means something that cost \$2 yesterday could cost \$4 next month. People need more money to buy the same amount of stuff. This makes the value of the money go down.

A little bit of inflation—around 2 percent per year—is normal. However, when prices rise by a lot or rise very quickly, it can be very hard for people to afford things they need.

**Facing the Facts**

Between 2019 and 2022, the price of bikes went up 43 percent. This is because so many people bought bikes during the COVID-19 pandemic that they were almost impossible to find.

In the United States, the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) protects, or keeps safe, the rights of disabled people. There are a lot of parts to the ADA. It covers accommodations at work and school, access to government programs, and many other things.

One example of something the ADA covers is access to public transportation, such as a city's subways and buses. The law says places where people get on or off these vehicles need to have things such as **braille** signs and doorways wide enough for wheelchairs. It's illegal for anyone to tell a disabled person they can't get on the transportation vehicle because they're disabled.

Companies are supposed to know what the ADA tells them to do, but sometimes they miss things. A lawyer, or person who knows the law, can help disabled people who suffer when the law isn't followed.



The ADA says people with disabilities don't have to use these seats, but if they want to, any able person sitting in one must move.

**Pollution**

Gases from burning fossil fuels don't just make the planet warmer. They also pollute the air, making it hard for people and animals to breathe. In fact, the World Health Organization (WHO) says that 4.2 million people die because of outdoor air pollution every year. This makes it one of the most common causes of death in the world.

People also pollute the water by dumping garbage or deadly chemicals into it. This makes it dangerous, or unsafe, for people to drink the water in some places. It also kills the plants and animals that live in or near the water.

There's a lot of plastic in the ocean, and more than half of it floats. Ocean currents push it together into five large areas called patches. The largest is the Great Pacific Garbage Patch, which is twice the size of Texas!
