The Bill of Rights

The representatives met in the Pennsylvania State House, it's now called Independence Hall.

In 1787, many representatives from most of the U.S. states arrived in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. They meant to change the first constitution they had created. The group soon decided the country needed a whole new constitution instead.

After much talking and arguing, the group came up with a new law of the land for the country. However, some representatives still didn't like it. They said the constitution needed a bill of rights. This is a list of individual rights and limits on government.

GEORGE MASON
George Mason (1725-1792) was a representative from Virginia who took part in creating the U.S. Constitution. Before that, he wrote the Virginia Declaration of Rights. When the time came to OK the U.S. Constitution, Mason wouldn't do it. He wanted a bill of rights. He also didn't like the power it gave the federal government.

THE ARTICLES OF CONFEDERATION
The Articles of Confederation was the first constitution of the United States. It was signed in 1781. This constitution gave little power to the federal government. At times, the government was so weak, it caused problems. That's when representatives met in 1787 to change things.

ANSWERING QUESTIONS

Facts are information based on proof. But where does this proof come from? Scientists use the scientific method to find evidence they can measure. An idea can be proven true after many experiments are done over and over.

Sir Francis Bacon is often called the father of the scientific method. He was the first person to make a true method for testing scientific experiments.

THE SCIENTIFIC METHOD

A scientist researches, or studies, a topic. They ask a new question with an answer they can measure.

- They write a hypothesis, or an educated guess. This is what they believe the answer will be.
- They create an experiment to test the hypothesis.
- They run the experiment and record what happens. This is evidence.
- They compare the results of their experiment with their hypothesis.
- They share their results with other scientists.

If their hypothesis was correct, the experiment is done many more times. If other people can do the experiment and get the same results, eventually this evidence can become a fact.

If their hypothesis is not correct, the scientist can write a new hypothesis based on their results. The process starts over.

SOCIAL MEDIA

Social media sites make keeping track of fake news even harder. Once people start sharing stories, it can get out of hand fast! Many times, people don't even take a closer look at links or sources. They just share the stories if they agree with them. Maybe they just look at the headline. Sometimes, people want to be the first to share something. Once something is trending on social media, it's hard to stop it.

People often share things online without reading more than the headline. This is a big way fake news spreads.

WHO DECIDES?

The Supreme Court is the highest court in the United States. It reviews cases that have gone through other courts. It also settles cases between states or between a state and the federal government.

The Supreme Court can rule that a state law is unconstitutional. Sometimes, it decides that something that used to be legal shouldn't be. It can also decide that some things that used to be illegal should be legal.

John Jay
The first chief justice of the Supreme Court was John Jay. He was appointed by President George Washington. He served from 1789 to 1795.

Thurgood Marshall
Marshall was the first African American named to the Supreme Court. He was appointed by President Lyndon Johnson. He served from 1967 to 1991.

Sandra Day O'Connor
O'Connor was the first woman named to the Supreme Court. She was appointed by President Ronald Reagan. She served from 1981 to 2006.

There are nine Supreme Court Justices. They're chosen by the president and approved by the Senate. The head of the Supreme Court is called the chief justice.

NUMBERS AND THE ELECTORAL COLLEGE

Numbers are important in the Electoral College. On election night, campaign workers watch the following numbers carefully. So do the news media and voters.

ELECTORAL STEPS

- There are 538 electors. Each state has as many electors as they do members of Congress.
- To win its president, that candidate must have at least 270 electoral votes. That's more than half of the total votes.
- Every 10 years, the number of a state's electoral votes is updated. This keeps it up to date with changes in Congress.

FAITHLESS ELECTORS
A faithless elector is one who doesn't cast their vote for the candidate their state's voters chose. This happened in elections in 1855, 1864, 1868, 1872, 1876, and 1955. These electors claim they had a good reason for what they did. They said they voted their conscience. In other words, they voted for what they believed.

REPUBLICAN DEMOCRAT

This map shows the number of electoral votes for each state in the 2016 presidential election. California has the largest number of votes due to its population.

Beethoven's Unfinished 10th Symphony Brought to Life by Artificial Intelligence

Nearly 200 years after his death, the German composer's musical scraps were pieced together by machines—with a lot of human help.

Carey: This is *Scientific American's* 60-Second Science. I'm Teresa Carey.

Every morning at five o'clock, composer Walter Werzowa would sit down at his computer to anticipate a particular daily e-mail. It came from six time zones away, where a team had been working all night (or day, sorry) to draft Beethoven's unfinished 10th Symphony—almost two centuries after his death.

The email contained hundreds of variations, and Werzowa listened to them all.

Werzowa: So by nine, 10 o'clock in the morning, it's like I'm already in heaven.

Carey: Werzowa was listening for the perfect time—a sound that was unmistakably Beethoven.

But the phrases he was listening to weren't composed by Beethoven. They were created by artificial intelligence—a computer simulation of Beethoven's creative process.

Werzowa: There were hundreds of options, and some are better than others. But then there is that one which grabs you, and that was just a beautiful process.

Carey: Ludwig van Beethoven was one of the most renowned composers in Western music history. When he died in 1827, he left behind musical sketches and notes that hinted at a masterpiece. There was barely enough to make out a phrase, let alone a whole symphony. But that didn't stop people from trying.

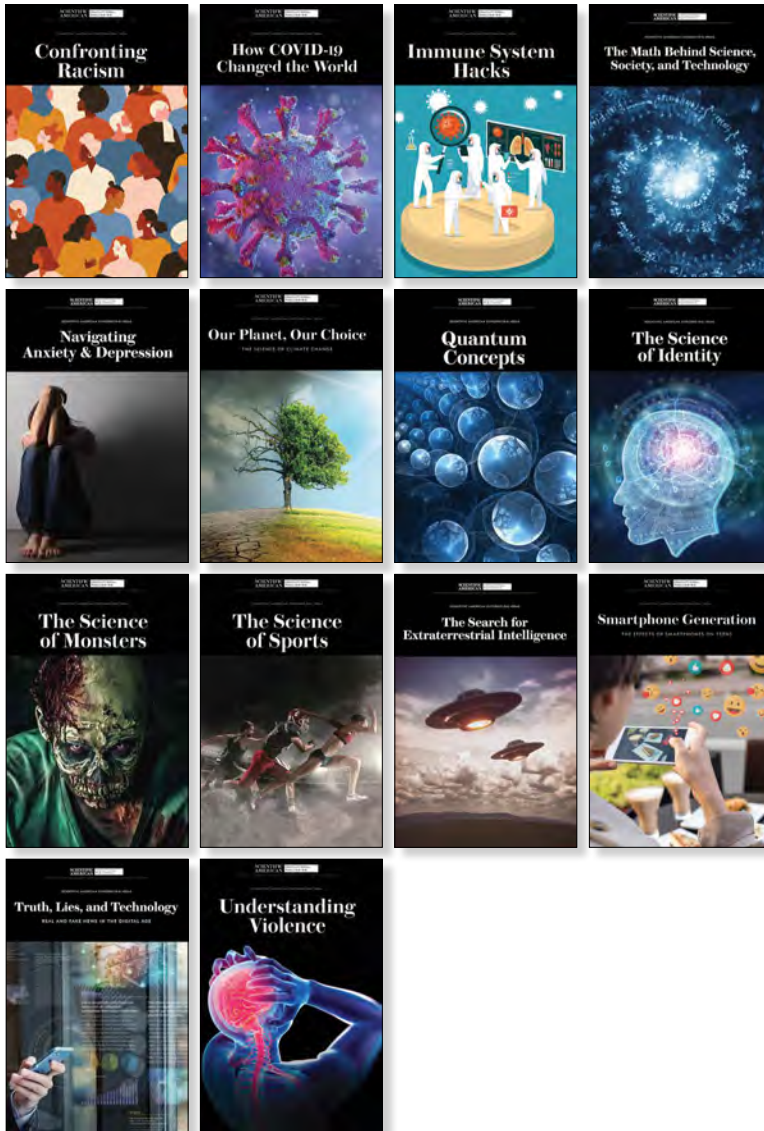

THE BASICS OF REPRODUCTION

BIRDS AND BATS

Eggs have some clear advantages, including being fragile and easy prey for predators. So why are there so many birds and bats that lay eggs? Because they fly! Possibly—but there are also around 1,000 species of flying mammal bats, and they manage to produce live young! Can you think of any other reason why all birds have such well-protected eggs?

→ A bat hangs from a tree branch with its young.

SACRIFICING LIVES

Many animals and plants do not (or hardly) sleep after producing young. Adult salmon swim up rivers to reproduce and then die without. Some grasshoppers guard and tend their eggs until they hatch but do not feed and so starve to death. There are even spider mothers that, after guarding their eggs, allow the young to eat their own body—the ultimate in self-sacrifice.

Some male angelfish attach themselves to a female, then literally become another part of her body (gills). This means surrounding structures degenerate (waste away), and the remains attached to the female for the rest of the life. You might wonder why such creatures bother to reproduce at all, it is because although the parent either degenerates or dies, its genes are passed on to the next generation (genes are inherited units of information carried by DNA.)

→ Some male deep-sea angelfish have very different life cycles than the female. This male angelfish has two males attached to his back. The males will never detach. They slowly grow into the female's body and only then reproductive structures remain.

THE STAGES OF LIFE

↑ These four-week-old prairie dogs are almost helpless. Although they have grown fat since being born naked, their eyes remain shut.

↓ A female Japanese tree frog carries eggs up a millipede the size of her leg for her young. Japanese tree frogs care for one of very few species of snails that look after their young. The mother lays her eggs in pools of water that collect in the hollow of a leaf. First, however, she kills any insect larvae in the pool that might eat her eggs. She also cleans the pool and mixes the water so it contains enough oxygen. After the eggs hatch, the mother slips up small snails for the young to eat.

BRITONS IN AMERICA

THE BRITISH EMPIRE

North America was one of the largest regions of the growing British empire. During the strength of the Royal Navy, the British held territory around Hudson Bay in Canada and on Caribbean islands. The British had also established trading posts in South America, West Africa, and South Asia. Over the next century, this network of posts would be the basis of an empire that stretched around the world—even though the British lost control of the United States.

Life in the Colonies

More than 10 million British subjects lived in colonial America by 1760. Most had never been to Britain; their families had moved to North America decades earlier. American society was thriving. Many colonists lived in busy cities such as Boston.

BRITONS IN AMERICA

Many people came to North America from Great Britain from the early 17th century onward. They did not think of themselves as Americans. They believed they were British people who just happened to live over the ocean. However, from 1763 they began to resent what they saw as restrictions on their liberties.

British warships defeated a Dutch fleet at the Battle of Comperdown in 1701. Britain's empire relied on its naval strength.

British roads often bring troops to Boston Harbor in 1768. The troops were sent to occupy the city to prevent patriot unrest.

SETTING UP A BLOCKADE

Setting Up a Blockade

President Kennedy made a TV address to the nation on October 22, 1962. As he spoke, he knew that three Soviet ships were close to Cuba. Another nine vessels were crossing the Atlantic. Kennedy was going to use the U.S. navy to stop them.

TASS STATEMENT

On the morning of October 23, 1962, the Soviet news agency TASS issued a statement. It accused Kennedy of breaking international law with the blockade and of piracy. It stated that the weapons piled on Cuba were purely defensive and not to attack the United States. The statement ended with the grim warning that U.S. actions might lead "to catastrophic consequences for world peace."

The Wrong Choice?

Just before Kennedy went on TV, he briefed Congressional leaders on the situation. Many thought the "quarantine" was too weak a response to the crisis. But Kennedy argued that he could not risk provoking the Soviet leader.

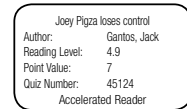
