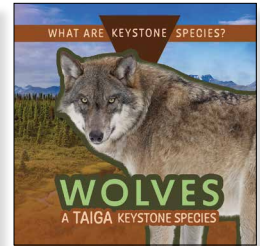
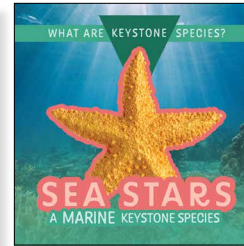
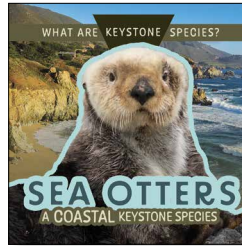
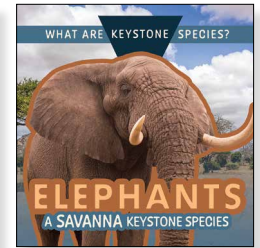
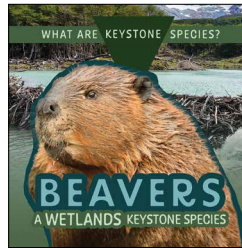
A long, woflike **HOWL** is a call to other pack members who are far away, for example when you leave the house. Some breeds, such as Siberian huskies, howl more than others.

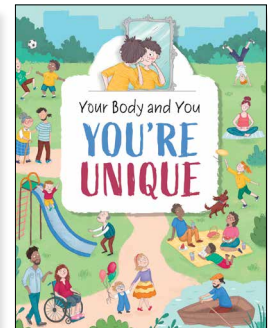
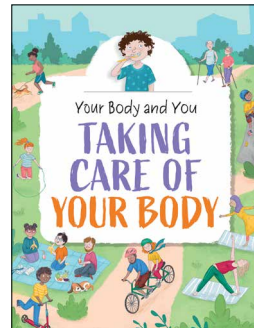
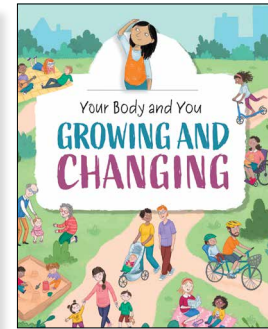
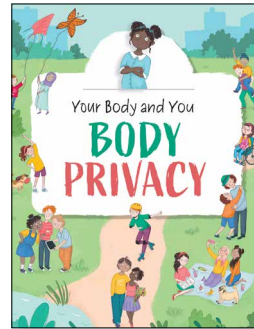
Your Body and You

LIGHTNING STRIKES!

Thunderstorms are caused by towering cumulonimbus clouds.

FAST AS LIGHTNING
Cumulonimbus clouds can grow when hot, wet air rises fast. Ice crystals, water drops and hail swirl about in these clouds, rubbing against each other. As they rub together, they make a type of electricity called static electricity. The electricity builds into a spark of lightning. The spark sets off a powerful disturbance in the air, known as a shockwave, which we hear as thunder.

COUNT IT OUT
We see lightning before we hear thunder because light travels faster than sound. Try counting the number of seconds between seeing lightning and hearing the thunder. Make sure you are safely indoors before you do any counting! Then divide the number of seconds by five to know how far away the lightning is in miles.

CHECK THE LIST
Lightning carries a powerful electric charge and can reach temperatures of more than 50,000°F (27,700°C)! If you are caught in a thunderstorm, consider these tips for staying safe.

- If you are outdoors, go inside immediately.
- If you are caught in the open, stay away from water, trees, and metal objects, which can attract lightning.
- If you are indoors, avoid water, and do not use electronic equipment or corded phones.
- If you feel your hair stand on end, squat close to the ground but do not lie on it. Put your hands on your knees and tuck your head between them.

GET OUT THERE!
MAKE RABBITS HOP USING STATIC ELECTRICITY.
You will need tissue paper, scissors, and a blown-up balloon. With an adult's help, cut the tissue paper into 10 simple rabbit shapes. Rub the balloon on your hair until your hair stands on end. The rubbing makes tiny particles called electrons move from your hair to the balloon. Now the balloon carries static electricity, which will attract some materials, such as tissue paper. If you hold the balloon near the tissue rabbits, they will jump onto it. Put your rabbits on a dry outdoor surface and see how many you can pick up in a minute. How many can your friends pick up?

THE ETHICS OF ROBOTICS

All AI comes with a lot of big questions, but the rise of intelligent robots is one area that has really gotten people thinking about the rights and wrongs of AI. Robotics is the field of study that explores how humans should behave as they design, build, and use artificially intelligent beings.

RIGHTS FOR ROBOTS

In 2017, the European Parliament agreed that there should be a set of laws that outlined robot rights. These laws would decide how artificial intelligence and robots should be developed and used. Early drafts of the laws included some basic rights and rules for robots. One of these is a state of "electronic personhood" for the most advanced intelligent robots, making them legally recognized beings.

AI IN ACTION

Sophia became the world's first robot "person" in 2017, when she became a citizen of Saudi Arabia. Sophia looks and acts very much like a human. She has more than 60 facial expressions, and she is able to learn human gestures that make her very lifelike.

MACHINE ETHICS

Ethical issues aren't just about how humans should treat robots. Ethics also need to consider rules that govern the way robots themselves should behave. This raises another question - should we be teaching robots right from wrong? Or should AI engineers be trying to design intelligent robots that have their own set of ethics? If robots don't decide their own laws like we do, can we say they're truly intelligent?

RIGHT OR WRONG?

Where do we draw the line in intelligent robots? AI can be used in many different areas, including medicine, health care, and the military. There is no doubt that intelligent robots can improve and even save lives. But they may also be used to harm others. Is that acceptable?

WHAT IF...? What if, one day soon, robots are able to experience a wide range of human emotions? Does that change how we should treat them? Is that the point at which they stop being machines and start being true cousins to the human race? If so, should they have the same rights and legal protections as we do? How might that threaten our own rights?

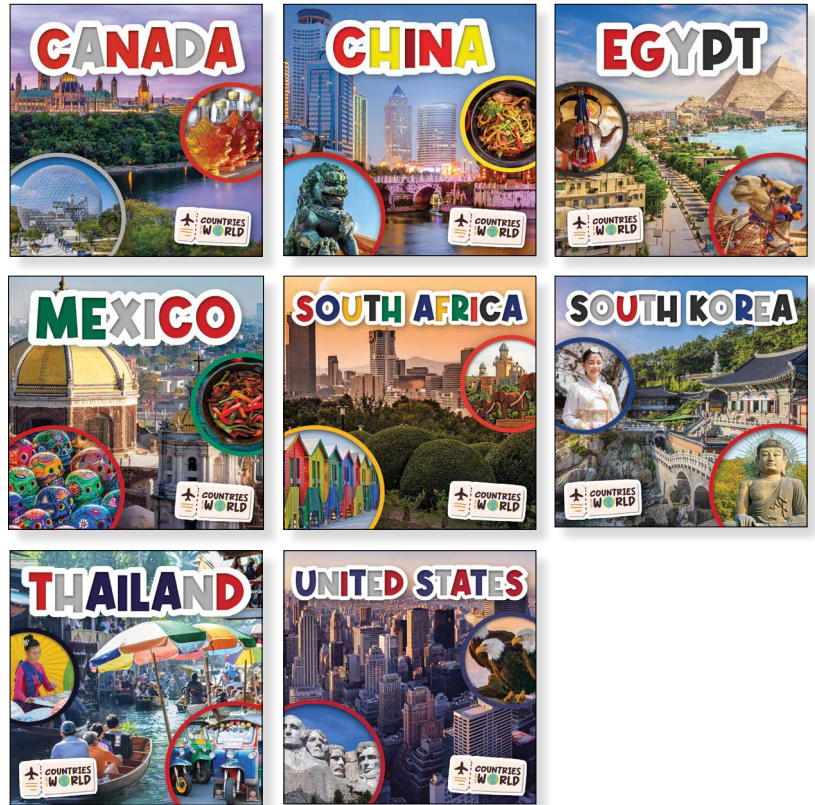

Animals, Land and Sea

The Northern Mariana Islands are home to a wide variety of animal life. Some species are endemic to the CNMI, meaning they live only on these islands and nowhere else in the world. Some of these species are **endangered** birds, including the Mariana crow. The destruction of this bird's habitat by typhoons and human activity is one reason for its disappearance. Another is the accidental introduction of the brown tree snake to the islands. The U.S. government is trying to stop this **invasive species** by using poisoned bait and snake-detecting dogs.


Some areas of the CNMI are set aside to allow birds and other native species to live away from people and their activities. This includes I'Chenchon Park Bird Sanctuary on the eastern side of the island of Rota.



MARIANA CROW

Territorial Truths ☆☆☆☆☆

The brown tree snake is believed to be responsible for the local extinction of 10 bird species on the nearby island of Guam.



The Mariana fruit dove is the Northern Mariana Islands' official bird. Also known as the *Paluman totut*, it's found across the islands. However, its population is falling.
