Conker the Chameleon

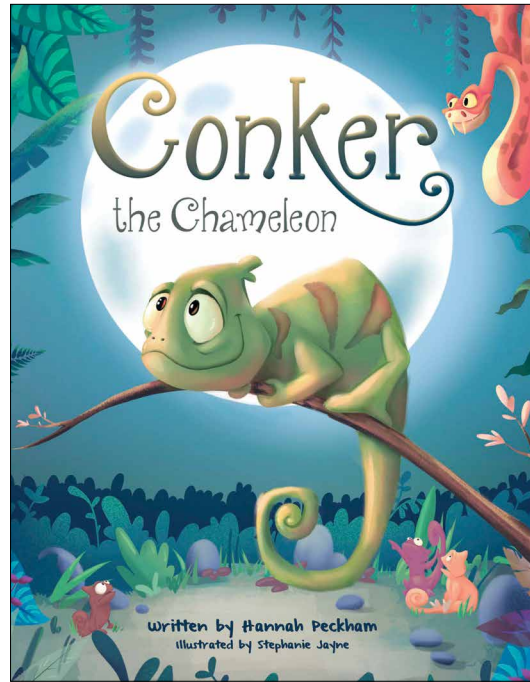
