HE REPUBLIC OF BENIN IS A presidential democratic republic. That means the nation is led by a president as the chief executive, with separate legislative and judicial branches. The people elect representatives to the government in free and fair elections, and multiple political parties exist to represent the various political views of the people. Suffrage is universal, beginning at age 18.

The capital of Benin is Porte-Novo, but the seat of governmen where most of the country's government buildings are located and me governmental activity takes place, is Cotonou. Benin is a secular natic meaning the government operates separately from any particular religion group. There is no official national religion.

Like many other nations with a recent colonial history, however, Benin has only existed as an independent nation for a few decades, and it is still struggling to find its footing, From 1975–1990, it was run as a Marxist-socialist state, which proved to be a debade. At that point it shifted to a democratic form of government, and since then, Benin has been heralded

Whether it is still operating as such is another question. In 2019, with Benin under the leadership of President Patrice Talon, the Democraci Index rated it a "hybrid regime." The index is compiled every two years by the Economist Intelligence Unit. a research and analysis company in the




